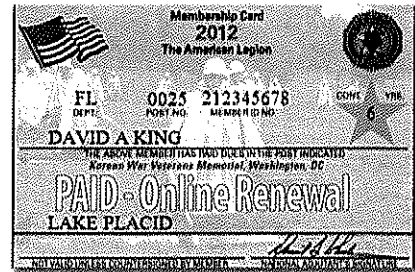


NEW On-Line Membership Renewal

Beginning July 1, 2011, all Legion members will be able to renew their 2012 membership on-line through www.legion.org. Members can renew using a credit card and print a temporary card. Members are instructed to mail or take their receipt to the post to receive their new card at no additional cost.



Posts will continue to have all cards sent with their roster. Notification of on-line renewals can be obtained directly from the myLegion post officer's site.
